A Certified Hand Therapist (CHT) is a licensed Occupational Therapist or Physical Therapist who has earned the designation by meeting and maintaining a strict set of standards set forth by the Hand Therapy Certification Commission (HTCC). These requirements include at least 3 years' experience and 4,000 hours of direct patient care related to the evaluation and treatment of the upper extremity, shoulder to hand. The culmination of certification requires the applicant to pass a rigorous certification examination which tests competency and knowledge in a wide scope of areas relating to the practice of hand therapy. The average passing rate is 59% with approximately 7,600 CHT's worldwide.

When you receive care from a Certified Therapist, you can be assured that they are committed to achieving the highest level of excellence in their field. Only certified hand therapists can use the credential CHT, and recertification is mandatory every 5 years. This ensures the therapist continues to stay current in their practice by earning continuing education hours beyond the requirements needed for their state licensure. It also ensures the therapist is actively working in the field of hand therapy for a specified number of hours.
